We object to the above for the following reasons:-

- 1. The fields between the canal and the railway walk should remain in agricultural use. This is because their agricultural character is an essential feature of the rural setting of the canal conservation area. Any public access to these fields would interfere with their agricultural
- 2. There are already adequate existing pedestrian accesses between the railway walk and the canal. Another one is unecessary.
- 3. There should be no vehicular access to the fields at the end of Follett Road and Glebelands Road except for farmers machinery. These roads and Tidcombe Lane are unsuitable for any additional traffic.
- 4. There should be no pedestrian access to the fields at the end of Follett Road and Glebelands Road except for farmers. Follett Road and Glebelands Road are unsuitable for additional street parking which would result from pedestrian access for visitors to these fields. Buses also have to use and turn in Glebelands Road which is already congested.
