I am a resident of Tidcombe Lane. We are very much against any escalation of traffic using Tidcombe Lane. It is already a short cut/rat run for vehicles coming and going to and from Cullompton and Tiverton. The lane is narrow in places and has two small bridges-one very old, it also runs through the Blundells School Complex. Cars sometimes already travel too fast and accessing the lane from our property (and other properties) and from Glebelands can be hazardous. The idea of creating an access route to a sports facility via Glebelands smacks of desperation and could only have been thought up by a robot! This is a residential area occupied mostly by older citizens!!

It just seems to us that the council is hellbent on destroying the one area of Tiverton ie; between Halberton and Blundells that is beautiful countryside, and in the process causing much distress and inconvenience to those who live there.
