Subject: Eastern Urban Extension

Traffic issues resulting from the proposed Eastern development have still not been resolved. Any increase in traffic on Blundell's Road, even in the early stages of the development, would have a serious effect on Blundell's School, a major employer in the town and an asset to the community and the county. The safety of pupils would be endangered. Traffic calming measures would be a frustration to drivers who would have no choice of a route into town, and to Tiverton High School, except to cut through Tidcombe Lane to Canal Hill. Tidcombe Lane itself is narrow, has two weak bridges and a Primary School on its boundary.

Uplowman Road, Golf Course Lane and Halberton are all narrow and unsuitable for increased amounts of traffic.

A clover leaf junction onto the A361 at the start of construction would alleviate the situation and a new road running from the west end of the development to Heathcoat Way, even if expensive, is necessary.
