- 1 While any animal is being kept under the authority of the Licence:-
  - (i) the animal shall be kept by no other person other than the person or persons specified on the licence;
  - (ii) the animal shall normally be held at such premises as are specified on the licence;
  - (iii) the animal shall not be moved from those premises except in the following circumstances, namely,
    - (a) to receive urgent veterinary attention
    - (b) in any other circumstances the Council approve in advance

when they must be transported and housed in suitable and secure accommodation

- (iv) the person to whom the Licence is granted shall hold a current insurance policy which insures him and any other person entitled to keep the animal under the authority of the Licence against liability for any damage which may be caused by the animal; and
- (v) the terms of any such policy shall be satisfactory in the opinion of the authority
- The species and number of animals of each species which may be kept under the authority of the Licence shall be restricted to those specified in the Schedule above.
- The person to whom the Licence is granted shall at all reasonable times make available a copy of the Licence to any person entitled to keep any animal under the authority of the Licence.
- The Licence only permits the buildings and enclosures outlined in red ink on the attached plan to be used to house the Dangerous Wild Animal(s).
- Any escape shall be notified by telephone to the Licensing Authority as soon as practicable.
- Appropriate steps shall be taken for the protection of the animals in case of fire or other emergency.
