Who can apply?

By implementing the key measures recommended by the ECO Stars Scheme, a typical taxi operator could expect to reduce fuel consumption by a minimum of 5% in the first year. Based on 40,000 miles per year at 39mpg and an average of £1.41 per litre of petrol or £1.45 per litre of diesel, there would be a saving of the equivalent of £330 per vehicle. That's equivalent to two years vehicle licence for a Hackney Carriage!

A typical taxi could also see annual output of carbon dioxide fall by over half a tonne per year!
