Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

Having studied the above document you will not I suspect be surprised to learn that my council is more than a little concerned that these proposals, if implemented, would result in town and parish councils not receiving any funds, which as the document clearly states would have resulted in parish and town councils receiving either 15% or 25% depending on whether they implemented a parish plan.

Whilst the arguments for retaining Section 106 may well be sound my council feels that it would only be fair that some form of payment was still made to parish and town councils. This argument is, to our mind, made even more sound by the fact that if you retain the principles of Section 106 you will stand to gain a great deal more financially; therefore you could clearly afford to make some form of payment to the applicable parish and town councils.

My council will look forward to your response to this in due course.
