(a) Title

Draft Supplementary Planning Document: Strategy to 2026 and Delivery Plan

(b) Subject Matter and area covered.

The draft SPD is Section 3 of the draft Green Infrastructure Plan. It contains policies for the provision and enhancement of green infrastructure, and proposals for funding and monitoring the delivery of the plan. It covers the entire Mid Devon District with the exception of a small area in Cheriton Bishop parish that falls within Dartmoor National Park.
