

Appendix 6 LIST OF, AND NOTES TO ACCOMPANY, MAPS

Maps 1 BSF Project Catchments

Sets out the catchment areas of the four 1st phase BSE Schools – Tiverton High School (Mid Devon), Chulmleigh Community College and Ilfracombe Community College (North Devon) and Dartmouth Community College (South Hams). A catchment area map for Marland School (Torridge) is not included as this is a Special School with a wide catchment across the district.

Maps 2 Sub Areas

Shows the sub areas used as a basis for presenting, and analysing, information

Maps 3 Pitch Sites

These show all pitch sport sites recorded and audited.

Maps 4 Bus Routes

Maps 5, 7 & 8 Football, Cricket and Rugby Pitch Quality

These show the quality scores for football pitch sites (Maps 5), cricket pitch sites (Maps 7) and rugby pitch sites (Maps 8). The categories relate to the scoring system used in the Playing Pitch methodology, although these have been slightly amended to reflect the local situation in Devon. Category 0-0.55 means that the pitches scored less than 55% (poor); 0.55-0.70 means they scored 55-70% (satisfactory); 0.70-0.75 means they scored 70-75% (good) and 0.75+ means they scored 75%+ (very good). The explanatory key will be clearer in the final version.

Maps 6 Football Matches played per ground

These maps are to show the amount of activity at each pitch site, according to numbers of league matches played (i.e. excluding cup and friendly matches). This gives some indication of the demand which is being met at each site, and can also be used as a basis for developing a hierarchy of provision.

Maps 9 Devon AGPs

This shows all full size and half-size artificial grass pitches in Devon. Catchments have been drawn for all those AGPs which are (a) full size, (b) have secure community use (categories A1-A3 under Sport England's classification) and (c) are floodlit.

Maps 10 Courts and MUGAs

These show tennis courts, multi use games areas and kickabout areas.

Maps 11 Sub Areas and Learning Communities

These maps show the Sub Areas and Learning Communities for the 4 BSF 1st tranche schools (i.e. in Tiverton, Ilfracombe, South Molton and Dartmouth). They also show catchment areas for walking to different types of pitch sites. They are still being perfected but give an indication of the range of data which can be mapped, as an aid to analysis and interpretation.
