As a resident affected by the above plan, my responses are as follows:

1. Along with most residents of the area I believe the proposed number of houses is too great and will alter the character of this small Devon market town. Facilities and services will be stretched and I would not want Tiverton to become basically a dormitory town. I would therefore welcome a plan which proposed the least number of new houses possible.
2. I hope some height restriction will be put upon any development in the proposed 'Employment' sector so that this area does not impinge too much on the character of the local area and upon already existing properties.
3. I realise that there are worries about the increased traffic flow along Blundell's Road affecting Blundell's School. A footbridge at the site of the present crossing would make crossing the road safer for the pupils and speed up traffic flow along the road - rather than expensive plans for yet another road running almost parallel to the present one.

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
