The new hospital is barely more than a geriatric centre totally insufficient to cope with yet another influx of residents. All over Tiverton there are 'For Sale' notices leading to the question if there are more houses available than being sold what is the need for yet more development. The expansion at Cullompton is in all directions and looks like a sprawled out mess, Tiverton can no longer be described as a small Market Town and the proposed Urban Extension is a step too far

The roads around Tiverton are mostly country lanes already utilized by far more traffic than ever intended. The North Devon Link Road has seen a large number of fatalities and Blundells Road has Blundells School and a number of residential properties using it on a regular basis.
