Having reviewed the plans, I wish to add the following comment on the planned eastern urban extension to Tiverton.

I am concerned about retaining the current environment surrounding the canal and railway walk. The area around the canal between Glebelands and the Aqueduct, including the railway walk is peaceful and scenic, giving easy access from the town to the countryside. If the urban extension expands in the area near the railway and the canal it will spoil this beautiful place.

The canal is advertised/marketed as a country park. There is a distinct difference between the first one & half miles at the Tiverton end of the canal surrounded by housing and the areas where there canal is bordered by open countryside.
