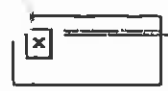

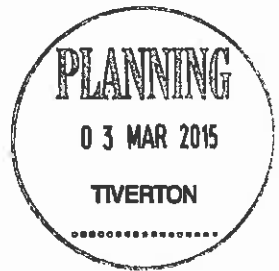
I write to object to the draft Charging Schedule. This objection is made in a personal capacity.

The zero rate in the urban extensions is not justified in the absence of any certainty that the necessary site and strategic infrastructure will be provided. The only way to ensure that infrastructure is provided is for a framework agreement to be completed that ensures that the land provides the infrastructure regardless of changes in ownership, in the design of schemes and the piecemeal development of the sites.
