We are residents of St. Georges View and have been for 33 years. A quiet, peaceful area, close to the town and countryside. Ourselves and most of our neighbours are over 50 and enjoy living in the cul-de-sac. We are all horrified at the thought of St. Georges View becoming a temporary access road to the proposed new housing estate. St. Georges View was built in 1963/64 and is so narrow that construction traffic would have difficulty passing each other. We remember when the houses were built at the end of Headweir Road, it was blocked off for safety and Headweir Rd is 60cm wider than St. Georges View. We would be taking our lives in our hands everytime we leave the front door, an accident waiting to happen. Surely this is something to be considered, the safety of the residents.

We have a lot of off-road parking from Willand Road, Hill Crest etc, where will they park?

We understand that there is a preservation order on the large oak tree at the end of the road, surely that must be preserved.

Is there no alternative plan? If the new link road between Willand Road and Tiverton Road was built first, from either end, all construction traffic could use it to build the new homes without causing any problems to existing residents.

Please take our views into consideration.
