I have looked at your proposals for re-development of the NW side of Cullompton & find it lacking in the request from the GPs over several years for a small plot of land behind their surgery. Do you not realise that with this surgery we have the finest facilities in the country & multiple after care treatment to keep Cullomptonians healthy & save the NHS money which benefits all. A small plot of land behind the surgery will complement the vegetable & herb garden & allow more people to enjoy this activity. At the moment there is only a very small space that we have & limits the amount of people that could benefit from this activity.

Also I need to bring to your attention your proposal to bring heavy lorries through St. Georges View. At the junction with Willand Road which is on a bend & noted during the 60's & 70's as a black spot when it was the A38, will become a dangerous place again. Already we have near misses travelling down the hill towards St. Georges View as people now park on the left of the hill & it is impossible to view the traffic approaching round the bend when you have committed to pass the parked cars. It would be prudent to make this area a no parking zone.

I was a resident of St. Georges View in the 70's-80's we had 33 children living in that road at the time & requested a pathway to enable them to walk to school safely without having to cross the main road, this fell on deaf ears but 30 years later when the children had all gone you put one in!  
So I am hoping the planning people we now have will take note of our concerns.
