Dear Sirs

I live on the corner of Westernlea and Pitt Hill in Credon.

I attended the public exhibition at Credon Area Office Council Chambers on Thursday 15 February 14 to find out about the possible intention of building houses on the two fields that are at the side of my property.

The field nearest me is extremely wet and some years ago there was a mention of building houses there and it was found to be too wet.

I am sure if building does take place the properties at the bottom of that field where the rain water runs down into the Chiddenbrook will most probably suffer from flooding.

Since the building of the houses at the top of Queen Elizabeth Drive the water going into the Chiddenbrook has been extremely heavy and consequently the houses that have the Chiddenbrook at the bottom of their gardens in Westernlea have recently

Had water almost flooding their gardens, so you can see that if more houses are built at Chapel Downs as well as the fields near me there is bound to be a problem with flooding.

Another point I would like to mention. There is a strip of land, which runs up the left hand side of Pitt Hill, which is part of my lawn. When we have heavy rain it runs down Pitt Hill like a river and this year in particular has caused this piece of lawn to become absolutely saturated.

I am extremely concerned what might happen if building takes place on these fields.
