Good Morning.

As a resident of Coplestone, I would like to register my objection to the proposed building of some 200+ new houses on the three proposed sites.

The facilities of the village could not cope with this increased head count.

The School could not accept such an increase.

The Transport system in this area is not capable of coping with this increase. The Bus service is inadequate on weekdays, and practically non-existent on Sundays. This will put additional strain on the very busy A377 in either direction. The section of the A377 going north from the village is already like a race track with a considerable number of drivers entering or leaving the village travelling in excess of the existing 30mph limit. This includes all classes of vehicles including tractors and trailers.
