WE OBJECT TO the proposed plans to build new houses at the Glebe site in Silverton. Our house is situated on the edge of the village at 26 Newcourt Road and just around the corner from one of the proposed sites. Our son regularly walks to school this way as it is a quiet country lane with little traffic in a beautiful conservation area. To turn it into a building site, and subsequent residential area, would mean ripping down hedges, disturbing the wildlife and having constant heavy duty traffic (adding to ever increasing potholes) followed by residential traffic clogging up the narrowest of lanes and making it unsafe for walkers/cyclists. Added to this is the fact the local primary school is already at full capacity and gaining a doctors appointment even now can be difficult at short notice - substantially more residents would make it impossible and be an added strain on our local surgery.
