Only 5 councillors were present the rest absent including the chairman so no clear information was explained to the public present. there was an overwhelming response to no large scale development but a small need for say 20 affordable homes and an agreement to support a small no of houses for young people with children to secure the viability of the school. We would like to register our objection to the initial proposal to build 185 houses on land to the rear of Hescare Park where we live on the Meadows Edge.

Obviously you are aware of approx 300 houses currently in Cherise Bishop & to add a further 200 or so would massively change the character of Cherise Bishop as a village.

In a recent Point Place questionnaire 46% of villagers responded and a need for 17 affordable houses was identified.

Please note our objection to the possible size of future development & also our personal desire of new houses overlooking us owing to the slope of the land and our elevated position.
