Re. Proposed Development of 195  
Houses at Henyock.

I am writing to express my  
objection to the above proposed  
development on the following grounds:-

1. The school cannot take more  
pupils than it already has and  
there is no scope to add to the  
buildings already there, nor to  
increase the size of the playground  
which is already too small.
2. The Blackdown Practice has expressed  
the view that it could not cope

with many extra patients

3. Despite Highways apparent approval of the scheme, anyone who lives in and around Hamyock will tell you that both the Culmstock Road and PIERROSS are over used ~~by~~ (particularly by enormous lorries) and dangerous. An extra 390 cars (average 2 per household) will bring Hamyock to a standstill.

You are proposing a large development at Willand where the road systems are far more able to cope with additional traffic as well as having better access to school, shops and jobs.
