After attending the Parish Council meeting on 3 February, I fully support the plan for the village to have 20 – 30 new houses over the next 5 – 10 years.

The mixture should be affordable housing and housing suitable for young families wishing to buy.

I support the move of the new school to Station Road. It is an excellent school deserving a better site and modern buildings.

Good pedestrian access to the new school will be needed.

An upgrade of the permissive path from Tytheing Close through Court Orchard with a bridge crossing of the Shuttern would greatly increase accessibility and safety.

The A377 is an ongoing problem. I fully support the P.C's efforts to persuade the Highways Department to accept how dangerous the fast traffic through the village is. An official safer road crossing point is essential.
