Dear Mr Baker

I am writing re: the above as I shall be unable to attend meeting on 3/3/ due to illness and profound deafness.

A lot of money has been spent on the School, and any further improvements I should think could be done a lot cheaper than rebuilding the school on another site. I do also wonder how many children there, come from the local area, or from Exeter, I know there is difficulty with parking but that's going to happen anywhere eg: Sutton Road + the junction with A377 is very dangerous with no way of widening it! and for the children walking it well!

As for new housing, that would be fine for the local people ^{from} ~~to~~ this village so 6 or so should be fine as long as they are for our own youngsters, then either Tything or Court Orchard where there are some houses already and a good entrance & exit, which there is at Tything close I don't know about Court Orchard would be ok.

Re: Building any houses on the School site, particularly if that includes the field behind the School buildings, then this should be turned down; the site would be very dangerous for any traffic going onto the A377 also any houses would look into the properties in Sand Down Lane, which would spoil our view & take our privacy.

I and my neighbour are horrified by the whole thing, who's going to pay for it, and at whose expense! DCC and MDDC seem to have money to burn, well there are plenty of things they should be spending their money on before these stupid notions. We will object strongly.
