I wish to make the following points:



- 1. I live in a thriving village, that has, over the years, had gradual development which has helped to maintain a social mix and a range of ages. I came to the village in the 1970s, when I was 27, and am now a state pensioner, having never really wished to move anywhere else. That says something about the village.
- 2. To prevent the village becoming full of old people like me, further careful development will help to provide an influx of younger people.
- 3. Of the 4 sites listed for potential development, the site known as Glebeland to the south of Drake's Meadow and Pynes Close would be unsuitable for development because of its status as a village amenity. Not just a place where people regularly walk their dogs, it is also a favourite for walkers generally and for tobogganing by children and adults when there is snow; some very fine trees including a double evergreen oak contribute to the field which is, because of its position on a north-facing hill, highly visible to the rest of the village, not just the adjacent neighbours. There is a strong feeling within the village that this field should be protected for the future enjoyment of the community, hopefully being identified as "green space".
- 4. There is an identified need for affordable/social housing, which should be provided for at the planning stage, together with improvements in public transport to help younger people who cannot afford to own a car.
