I am writing concerning the current review of the local plan, to include building 195 houses in Hemyock outside the current village boundary.

I am opposed to these plans on the following grounds:

- the infrastructure of the village is already at breaking point with sewage overflowing at Longmead, Hemyock
- there will be an increased risk of flooding on Station Road and the Culmbridge North site is on a flood plain that floods regularly
- the roads are already struggling to cope with the amount of traffic in the village, with particular problems on Station Road and the roads in and out of the village
- the schools have limited capacity to take more children
- the surgery may also have problems taking on new patients
