Subject: Local Plan Review - Hemyock

I am writing to record my objection to the suggestion that a further 200 houses should be built in Hemyock outside the existing settlement limits.

My objections are based on

1. The fact that the **existing** road pattern and widths are **not able to cope** satisfactorily with existing traffic flows and there many places where roads are not wide enough for 2 vehicles to pass. Therefore further house building will only exacerbate the positions.
2. Flooding is a frequent problem and further building will make matters worse especially from surface water run off.
3. The character of the village in an AONB will be further eroded as it becomes more and more a dormitory for surrounding towns.
