Proposed Redevelopment at J27 and area

Would you please record our strong objection to the huge proposed redevelopment of the area between J27 of the M5 and Willand. It is far too big; would alter the whole character of the countryside; would be detrimental to Tiverton, Cullompton and Willand by taking away trade; is not needed and there is no call for it.

Cullompton in particular, is struggling to develop itself. It has a new library; community and conference centre; shortly to open the refurbished Walronds House; a thriving Farmers' Market, and occasional small street market. The new housing development at Kingfisher Reach is providing more accommodation. Cullompton, in its ideal location within a short distance of the M5, would benefit by more land being made available for housing, together with improved infrastructure: additional primary school; enlarged secondary school; road improvements to take through traffic away from the High Street, for example. Even the re-opening of the railway station. Cullompton is the right and appropriate place for development, but not, and we stress NOT the size of the proposed redevelopment at J27.
