I wish to object to the the inclusion of land off Bowdens Lane in the local review plan with it's potential for the development of 51 houses.

I feel that this is not an appropriate development as it means building on good agricultural land. Further I believe it will also lead to the destruction of wild life habitat.

Also within a village of little more than 80 or so houses a development of a further 51 houses is disproportionate and will lead to the destruction of the village's character, increased traffic levels, heightened noise levels, increased air and light pollution and put a strain on the local sewage treatment works.

As no employment opportunities exist in Shillingford and very few exist in the nearby town of Bampton any people living on this proposed development would need to travel some distance to get to work which would lead to a significant increase in car journeys through Bampton which already has notoriously bad traffic flow issues and where it is often dangerous for pedestrians who have to negotiate double parked cars, lorries and buses to cross the road.

Further, Bowdens Lane is a very narrow road and with 51 properties there would be a large number of families who would need to drive their children to school. This would lead to high traffic levels at certain times of the day on this narrow lane which is currently only used by farm vehicles and a few locals for whom the road is the way to their home. At other times of the day I believe there would still be a significant increase in traffic levels as a result of these houses which would pose a danger to young children walking to use the local play park in Bowdens Lane.
