WE OBJECT TO THE PROPOSAL OF 51 HOUSES BEING BUILT IN THE VILLAGE OF SHILLINGFORD, NR. BAMPTON ON THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS..

- THE SIZE OF THIS PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT WOULD PUT EXCESSIVE STRAIN ON THE ALREADY STRETCHED LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE SUCH AS SCHOOLS (ALREADY FULL), HEALTH CENTRE AND SEWAGE WORKS.
- ACCESS TO THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT IS BY A NARROW, BUSY ROAD LEADING TO THE B3227 WHICH ITSELF IS A BUSY ROAD, POSING SAFETY ISSUES FOR PEDESTRIANS & MOTORISTS.
- MANY OF THE OCCUPANTS OF THE 54 NEW PROPERTIES (3 ALREADY APPROVED), WOULD OWN A VEHICLE, AND SOME MAY HAVE MORE THAN ONE VEHICLE, THE CONSIDERABLE AFFECTS OF WHICH WOULD REACH FARTHER AFIELD THAN THE IMMEDIATE VILLAGE.
- IT WOULD BE DIFFICULT TO PUT PAVEMENTS IN WITHOUT ENCROACHING ON EXISTING GARDENS OF PROPERTIES IN BOWDENS LANE LEADING TO THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT.
- TRAFFIC FLOW AND PARKING IN THE NEIGHBOURING TOWN OF BAMPTON, ALREADY STRETCHED, WOULD BE MADE WORSE BY THE INEVITABLE EXTRA VEHICLES, AS STATED ABOVE.
- SHILLINGFORD HAS NO FACILITIES SUCH AS A SHOP, PUB, SCHOOL OR CHAPEL.
- SHILLINGFORD HAS A LIMITED BUS SERVICE.
- THE SIZE OF THIS PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT WOULD HAVE A HUGE IMPACT ON SHILLINGFORD, ALMOST DOUBLING ITS SIZE.
- 51 HOUSES, TOGETHER WITH 3 ALREADY APPROVED AND AT AN AVERAGE OF 1.5 OCCUPANTS EACH, MAKES FOR AROUND 80 MORE INHABITANTS IN THIS SMALL RURAL VILLAGE.
- AT A MEETING WITH OVER 80% TURNOUT, THE OVERALL CONSENSUS, FOLLOWING A SHOW OF HANDS, WAS AGAINST THE PROPOSAL AND IT WAS REMARKED THAT THERE ARE PLACES WHERE A DEVELOPMENT SUCH AS THIS WOULD BE BETTER RECEIVED AND EVEN ENDORSED.
