Subject: Development plans for Junction 27 and Willand

We were concerned about the proposed plans for the development of Junction 27 and Willand prior to the meeting held at Willand Village Hall. Since attending that meeting we are even more concerned.

It seems that there are no plans to provide additional adequate infrastructure to cater for the influx of extra residents in turning Willand Village into a town. We understand the companies who were responsible for previous developments in Willand were required to make proper provision infrastructure wise for the additional homes. However this was never done and the council did not enforce this requirement.

Consequently the services available in Willand are already hard pressed to cope especially the school which no doubt is already finding it difficult to deal with an influx of non-English speaking children.

The prospect of the disruption that will ensue is deeply disturbing. Extra traffic on small local roads, pressure on our tiny doctors' surgery which is only open part time, lack of additional school places plus refuse and recycling problems , overcrowding, noise, pollution and so forth are all causes for concern.

The impression, certainly at present, is that all this is an ill conceived idea which definitely needs reviewing or abandoning
