Solar PV Developments in the Landscape Supplementary Planning Document

Adoption Statement in accordance with regulation 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

The Solar PV Developments in the Landscape Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted at a meeting of the Mid Devon District Council on 9 June 2016.

Modifications

In accordance with regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 this adoption statement sets out pursuant to Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 the modifications to the Solar PV Developments in the Landscape SPD that have been made since the draft document was subject to consultation. The changes are as follows:

- i) Addition of a separate summary document to accompany the final SPD.
- ii) Addition of a user guide within the final document.
- iii) Addition of a key principles section within the final document.
- iv) Policy DM27 added to the list of relevant policies, included at Table 2.1 of the SPD.
- v) Reference to registered parkland estates within the district, as well as Killerton, have been included in relevant sections of the SPD, with cross reference to setting studies (Killerton and Knightshayes) provided in footnotes.
- vi) Updates to text to address minor typographical errors.

Legal Challenge

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Solar PV Developments in the Landscape SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Solar PV Developments in the Landscape SPD was adopted.
