

Adoption Statement

Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

The Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) was adopted at a meeting of the Mid Devon District Council on 26 October 2016. The document sets out the Council's policy on consultation and public participation when local plans or supplementary planning documents are prepared and planning applications considered.

The Council has modified the SCI to take into account representations made in relation to the document and any other relevant matters. Modifications are included in the Statement of Consultation.

Legal Challenge

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Statement of Community Involvement was adopted.
