THE ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT REGULATIONS 2015 PART 5**

NOTICE is given that from 30 May 2018 to 10 July 2018, excluding Saturdays and Sundays and Bank Holidays, between the hours of 10.00am and 1.00pm and 2.30pm and 4.30pm any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounting records of the Mid Devon District Council for the year ended 31 March 2018 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents relating thereto. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection at the offices at which they are normally kept or otherwise by arrangement; application should be made initially to the Director of Finance, Assets & Resources, Phoenix House, Phoenix Lane, Tiverton (Tel: 01884 255255).

NOTICE is also given that from 30 May 2018 to 10 July 2018, excluding Saturdays and Sundays and Bank Holidays, at the request of a Local Government Elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the Elector or his/her representative an opportunity to make written objections as to any matter in respect of which the Auditor could take action under Section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. The written notice of objection must state the facts on which the Elector relies, the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- i) any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to law; and
- ii) any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 to, the Act.

The written notice of objection must be addressed to the Auditor, Grant Thornton UK LLP, of Hartwell House, 55-61 Victoria Street, Bristol, BS1 6FT.
