

Terms and conditions

1. By entering the competition, entrants are deemed to have accepted, and agreed to be bound by, these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry to the competition is open to all pupils attending primary schools or home schooled in the Mid Devon District.
3. The closing date for entries is **midnight on Tuesday 8 May 2018**
4. Entrants must draw or paint a picture, at school or at home, on a A4 piece of paper using “what Mid Devon District Council collects as part of the kerbside food waste and/or subscription based garden waste collection” as their theme.
5. The picture should reflect a positive message to inspire people to recycle or show what they can recycle in Mid Devon.
6. Schools may submit multiple entries, but only **one entry per pupil** will be accepted.
7. The drawing must be of food and garden waste and **illustrated on A4 paper in landscape**, photographic entries will not be accepted.

11. Winning entrants will have a lorry named after them (first name only, no nicknames or abbreviations), with their artwork displayed on the body of the lorry.
12. The winning pupils will be notified in writing by **Friday 18 May 2018**.
13. Mid Devon District Council accepts no responsibility for late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, delayed or misdirected entries.
14. Mid Devon District Council will appoint a fair and impartial judging panel to judge the entries and select winners. The winners will be selected from all valid entries.

15. Winning pupils must be willing to participate in publicity surrounding the winning of the competition and consent to Mid Devon District Council and partner organisations using the submitted drawings for publicity purposes.
16. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into other than to notify the winning entrants.
17. These terms and conditions are governed by English Law and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
