Prevent and Detect Harm, Protect the vulnerable

# Our Aim is to detect and prevent harm to those most at risk.

- Identify a running list for;
- The most at 'risk' missing Children in Exeter, East and Mid Devon.
- The most 'frequent' missing from locations
- The top found locations or 'in company with'

By identifying these areas the team can focus on reducing vulnerability, reducing demand and targeting those who pose a risk to missing children.

# Progression, Safeguarding and Management

- Deal with all missing cases involving those identified in the top 'risk' category
- Engage with premises and partners to reduce the demand . Take action to improve practices around reporting, identify the legal obligations on our partners.
- Identify key locations missing people visit, discover why and enhance prevention methods in these areas.
- Target offenders who we suspect are harbouring children, supplying alcohol and drugs, trafficking children and exposing them to CSE.
- Utilise abduction notices, build cases and seek prosecution.

# Relationships
