Police definition of hate crime:

"Any criminal offence which is perceived, by the victim or any other person, to be motivated by a hostility or prejudice based on a person's race or perceived race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or transgender".



Purpose of the report

- Highlight good practice
- Identify challenges across Devon relating to Planning policy
- Provide recommendations that encourage all local authorities in Devon to work collaboratively and consistently





Findings

- Gypsy and Traveller Forums established in Teignbridge and Mid Devon
- Demonstrating commitment to Equality and Diversity
- Generation of educational tools to help dispel myths

- Provision of tools that TDC and MDDC have used to establish Forums
- TDC- SPD on size of pitches
- EDDC- consultation re: Cranbrook





Areas for development

- Improved Housing needs assessment approach/bi-annual count limitations
- Identified land for sites (permanent, and temporary stopping places)
- Stigma and Discrimination still exists and needs to be challenged at every opportunity

- Need to do more to improve housing and health of the Gypsy and Traveller population
- No measurement of costs attributable to unauthorised encampments





Next Steps

- All Devon local authorities being invited to develop a policy for negotiated stopping places that we hope will lead to an unauthorised encampment policy
- Recommendation that all Devon local authorities start to collate data on the number and costs of unauthorised encampments



A new Plan for Mid Devon


Provide between 2014 and 2034:


