
## Tree constraints plan



## Information for designers

'A' Category: <u>The most important trees</u> considered as a material constraint. This may include veteran or ancient trees which are particularly important. 'A' trees should be retained unless there are

'C' Category: In our opinion, it is reasonable to assume these trees could be removed because they are very small, low/poor quality/health, are causing damage/inconvenience or their removal

U' Category: Unsuitable for retention because they are dead, in

Default Root Protection Area (RPA). Using stem diameter, this is the default area where roots should be protected. For new development, this area should be avoided as far as possible for retained trees. Excavation is not permitted in this area but it may be possible to use bespoke construction methods in some instances.
