Ideally to be retained but sometimes development won to be possible without their removal but it should be kept to minimum and well designed mitigation planting provided. 'C' Category: In our opinion, it is reasonable to assume these trees could be removed because they are very small, low/poor quality/health, are causing damage/inconvenience or their remover will provide tree management benefits.
