I commend the Town Council and its partners for spending the time on this project and for the level of detail contained within it.

My concern is that CCA Fields have not been designated as Local Green Space, which they clearly are.

Also, Cullompton has quite a number of older, significant buildings which are not in Fore St/High St, but which form an important part of the historic fabric of the Town and so I think that it is important that these should not be forgotten when thinking about preservation.

Note: Declaration of interest - I do live in what is probably the oldest house in the Town and the only thatched house remaining in the Town Centre.

I would like to see mention of the character of St Andrews' churchyard being maintained as precisely that, a place of quiet reflection and respect, and NOT a space for the playing ball and other games, which it has become.
