THE ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT REGULATIONS 2015 PART 5**

NOTICE is given that for 30 working days between 5th July 2021 to 13th August 2021 (inclusive), excluding Saturdays and Sundays and Bank Holidays, any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounting records of the Mid Devon District Council for the year ended 31 March 2021 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents relating thereto. Due to Covid-19 the accounts and other documents will be available for inspection by appointment only at the offices at which they are normally kept; application should be made via e-mail to corporatefinance@middevon.gov.uk

NOTICE is also given that from 5th July 2021 to 13th August 2021, excluding Saturdays and Sundays and Bank Holidays, at the request of a Local Government Elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the Elector or his/her representative an opportunity to make written objections as to any matter in respect of which the Auditor could take action under Section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. The written notice of objection must state the facts on which the Elector relies, the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- i) any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to law; and
- ii) any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 to, the Act.

The written notice of objection must be addressed to the Auditor, Grant Thornton UK LLP, 2 Glass Wharf, Bristol, BS2 0EL.
