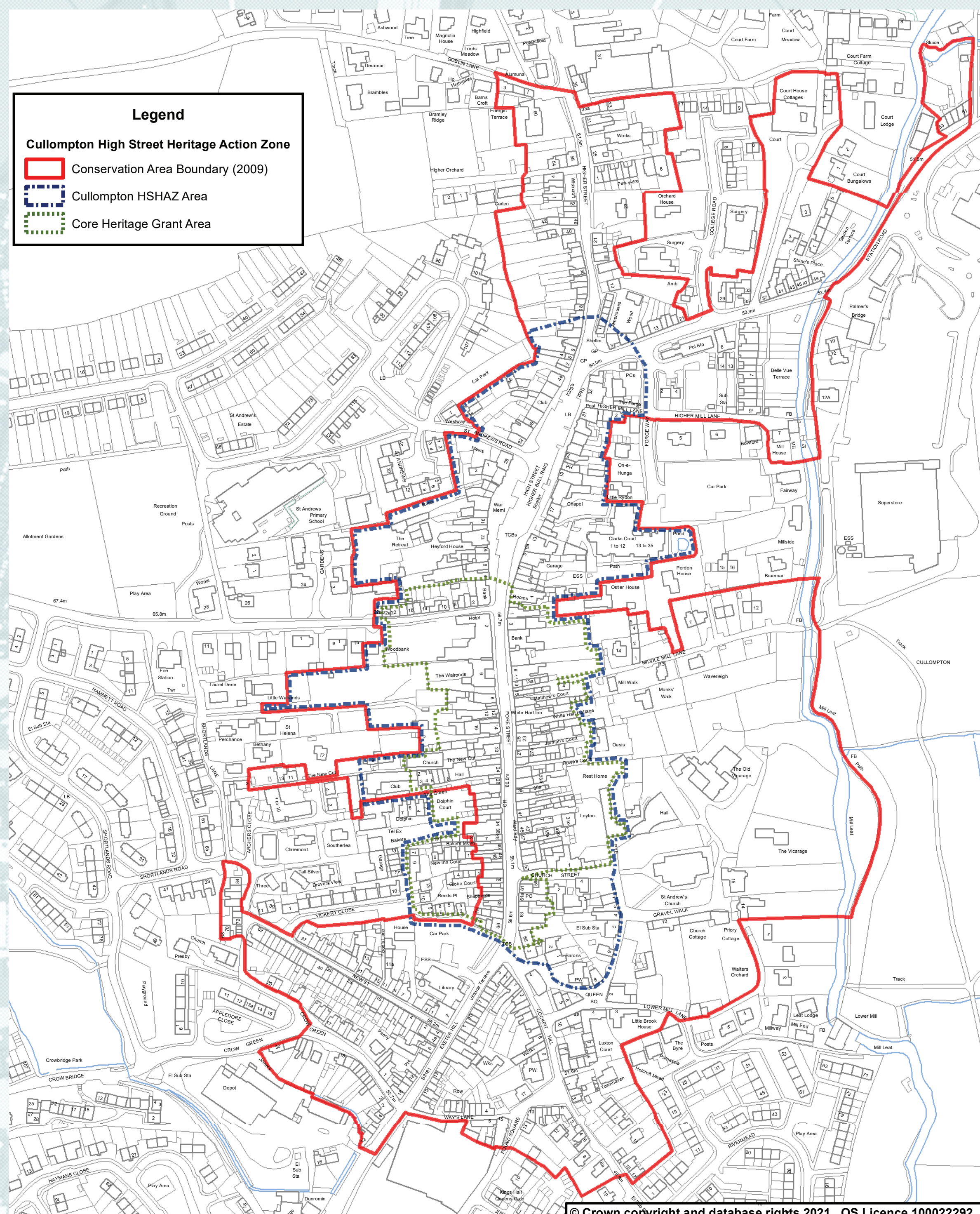

## High Street Heritage Action Zone

The Cullompton HAZ is part of a national project aiming to unlock the potential of high streets across England, fuelling economic, social and cultural recovery, with over 60 high streets offered funding. Cullompton is one of only 10 successful High Streets in the South West region. The project runs to March 2024.

We want to make Cullompton Town Centre a more desirable place for businesses, visitors, investors and local people, by:

- Encouraging new and sustainable cultural activity in the high street areas;
- Helping improve perceptions of the high street and its heritage;
- Restoring and enhancing the local character of the high street area.



## Projects

The Cullompton HAZ incorporates a number of projects, including:

- Public realm improvements around the Higher Bullring (with Devon County Council);
- A grants scheme for building repairs and historic reinstatement work;
- A cultural programme of activities in the town centre to align with the town centre's heritage; and
- An updated Cullompton Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan (CAMP), as well as a new Mid Devon District Council Shopfront Design Guide.

## Grant funding

Building improvement grants are now available to support the repair and restoration of the historic town centre.

Building owners and leaseholders can apply for grants to support structural and historic reinstatement work covering properties in the HAZ core grants area and within the Conservation Area.

Shopfront improvement grants are also available for properties in the HAZ and Conservation Area.

## How to get involved

Look out for a range of consultation events over the course of the project, including on the high street public realm project, the CAMP, the Town Centre Masterplan and the cultural programme.
