Dear Forward Planning Team,

Thank you for providing National Highways with the opportunity to comment on the submission draft of the Crediton Neighbourhood Plan. National Highways is responsible for operating, maintaining and improving the strategic road network (SRN), which in this case comprises the A30 trunk road approximately 6km south and the M5 motorway approximately 10km east of the plan area.

We are satisfied that the proposed policies within the submission draft Plan are unlikely to result in development which will adversely impact the SRN and we therefore have no specific comments to make. This does not however prejudice any future responses National Highways may make on site specific applications as they come forward through the planning process, and which will be considered by us on their merits under the prevailing policy at the time.
