please stop cutting vegetation and grass so much and let areas grow wild, for example, the patch of ground at the turn off to Ashley.

More trees could be planted along the Walrons, and at the Blundells Road roundabout area.

Also, make the local farmers stop cutting their hedges so often, we need all the trees we can get, and there are literally thousands of trees already in the hedgerows just waiting to grow, if only farmers would stop cutting. This would save them fuel, time and reduce soil compacting.

How about putting up Swift nestboxes on the taller buildings, as there are very few places for them to nest in town. This is also the case for Starlings, which are also getting scarce.
