

Data Protection Privacy Notice – Mid Devon Call for Sites

Why are we processing your information?

All personal information in respect of call for sites submissions will be processed in accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.

What will your information be used for?

Mid Devon District Council will use your information for the purposes of preparing a technical assessment of housing and economic land availability across the district. Any site submissions received will be published on the Council's website but all personal information will be redacted from public viewing. We will however hold this information on our consultation database.

Who will your data be shared with?

Your information will not be shared with any other person or organisation outside of Mid Devon District Council (with the exception of Devon County Council during the six-week call for sites process, whereby the County Council will act as the Data Controller).

The Data Controller

During the initial call for sites process, Devon County Council will be the data controller. However, once the window for site submissions has closed, all data will be transferred securely to Mid Devon District Council. Thereafter, the data controller will be Mid Devon District Council, Phoenix House, Phoenix Lane, Tiverton EX16 6PP
