
*Dear Rev'd Johnson*

I refer to your letter of 17 April sent to the Knightshayes Estate Office. I drafted a response at the time but it appears that this wasn't sent so please accept my fulsome apologies for that.

My answer explained that the Tomswell Allotments belong to the Knightshayes Estate and are on lease to the Tiverton Town Council. The Trustees are happy that that should continue but do not wish to designate the area for any particular purpose in perpetuity.

Similarly with the other two spaces you mention: Leat Street Open Space (which is at present mostly allotments) and the small area of John Street allotments. These belong to Lowman Manufacturing Co whose directors also do not wish to change the designation in perpetuity.

Again my apologies for a lack of response until now.
