What are we consulting on?

Mid Devon District Council is holding an 8-week public consultation on a draft Non-Statutory Interim Planning Policy Statement: Climate Emergency. This follows the Council's adoption of the Devon Climate Change Declaration and the Mid Devon Climate Strategy 2020-2024. We are seeking your views on the Planning Policy Statement, which will support relevant policies in the adopted Mid Devon Local Plan and introduce interim measures while we are preparing 'Plan Mid Devon', which will be a new local plan for the district. It will help underline that tackling climate change is an important material consideration in the planning process.

The Planning Policy Statement will apply to all planning applications for the development and use of land and buildings in Mid Devon, except those within the Dartmoor National Park or that are subject to 'permitted development rights' where there is no need to apply for planning permission.

When are we consulting?

The consultation period will take place **from Monday 24th October 2022 to Friday 16th December 2022**.

What you need to know when submitting a representation

Formal representations should be made in writing (postal or electronic) and must be received on or before Friday 16th December 2022. When making a representation you must include your name and full postal address, otherwise your comments cannot be registered.

The information you provide will be used by Mid Devon District Council to help inform the preparation and implementation of the Non-Statutory Interim Planning Policy Statement: Climate Emergency, and any representations received will be published on the Council's website after 16th December 2022, including your name and address. Your contact details will not be shared with any other person or organisation outside of Mid Devon District Council.
