1 These tables include information on new prevention and relief duties owed. Prevention duties include any activities aimed at preventing a household threatened with homelessness within 56 days from becoming homeless. Relief duties are owed to households that are already homeless and require help to secure settled accommodation.

They are not comparable with the homelessness decisions or prevention/relief activity reported prior to May 2018. This is because amendments to legislation, as introduced by the 2017 HRA, have introduced new duties that mean more people will be eligible for assistance out of homelessness from local authorities.

18 local authorities had missing data on initial assessment information. National and regional totals were weighted based on previous trends for these authorities: Amber Valley, Blaby, Brent, Brentwood, Cambridge, Canterbury, Colchester, Croydon, Erewash, Halton, Hounslow, Milton Keynes, Newark & Sherwood, Newcastle, Ribble Valley, Salford, Warwick, and Wyre Forest who had missing data this quarter but have accurate published figures in previous quarters. They are highlighted and referenced in the data tables, and are estimated to comprise of 6.9% of total assessments in England. There may be seasonal trends in this data, which is not currently adjusted.

2 19 local authorities had missing data on prevention and relief outcomes. Therefore the corresponding regional totals were weighted to account for these. These authorities were: Amber Valley, Bedford, Brent, Cambridge, Canterbury, Croydon, Erewash, Halton, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Kensington & Chelsea, Lambeth, Milton Keynes, Newark & Sherwood, Newcastle, Portsmouth, Ribble Valley, Salford, and Warwick who had missing data this quarter but have accurate published figures in previous quarters. These are estimated to comprise of 7.3% of prevention outcomes and 10.4% of relief outcomes in England.

3 Main duty describes the duty a local authority has towards an applicant who is unintentionally homeless, eligible for assistance and has priority need. This definition has not been changed by the 2017 HRA. However, these households are now only owed a main duty if they did not secure accommodation in the prevention or relief stage.

17 local authorities had missing data on main duty decisions. Therefore the corresponding regional totals were weighted to account for these. These authorities were: Amber Valley, Cambridge, Canterbury, Croydon, Erewash, Halton, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Kensington & Chelsea, Lambeth, Milton Keynes, Newark & Sherwood, Newcastle, Ribble Valley, Salford, Thanet, and Warwick. These are estimated to comprise of 9.6% of total main duty decisions in England.

17 local authorities had missing data on main duty outcomes. Therefore the corresponding regional totals were weighted to account for these. These authorities were: Amber Valley, Brent, Cambridge, Canterbury, Croydon, Erewash, Halton, Hounslow, Lambeth, Milton Keynes, Newark & Sherwood, Newcastle, Ribble Valley, Salford, Waltham Forest, Warwick, and Windsor & Maidenhead who had missing data this quarter but have accurate published figures in previous quarters. These are estimated to comprise of 6.5% of total main duty outcomes in England.

Data in each new release is provisional and subject to revision in future quarters. Local authorities may add new cases late or revise previous data submissions where mistakes have been spotted.

Where revisions to earlier quarters are made, these will be incorporated into the dataset at the end of the financial year.




