Application for designation of a Neighbourhood Area – Silverton

I write in response to your letter dated 4th April 2014.

The Trust has no objection in principle to the proposed neighbourhood area boundary. However, the Trust has a significant interest in the area in that part of the Trust's Killerton estate, including Silverton Mill, falls within the plan area (the area of Trust ownership within Silverton Parish is shown on the attached plan), and so it would like assurance that it would be consulted during preparation as a key stakeholder.

I also draw your attention to the Killerton Setting Study, as a large part of the parish/plan area falls within the setting study area identified as significant to the setting of Killerton (also shown on attached plan).

A more detailed plan of land in the Trust's ownership can be provided. Also a copy of the Killerton Setting Study can be submitted for the evidence base in due course.
