I am writing to object to the planning ideas put forward in relation to the above.

For you to even consider building house/schools/industrial parks etc on greenbelt land – particularly that of high agricultural value – is totally unacceptable. I live in Rull Lane and we moved here for the views and the tranquillity of the countryside. We turned a barren water meadow on our land into a haven for wildlife by installing two ponds and planting hundreds of trees and shrubs. It is full of ducks, moorhens, coots, the occasional swans and Canada Geese in the winter. There is an abundance of other wildlife in the fields surrounding October Cottage and to think that this could be desecrated by concreting it over is absolutely devastating.

The traffic in Cullompton is completely gridlocked at rush hour, with queues snaking back in all directions. To even consider adding to this is madness, considering that you are looking at building 1,000 new houses, with an average of two vehicles per household. Besides, where would all these people work? Who could afford to buy them? This just has not been considered.

I beg you to reconsider this plan. The countryside is precious and should be cherished, not annihilated. If you must build houses, please build them on brownfield sites. Once it's gone, it's gone.
